UNISON membership

- All RCOT members are members of UNISON (except for those who are wholly self-employed or employed overseas).
- UNISON represents members in many ways, from advising and supporting individual members about a problem at work, to using its voice to influence decision-making at a national level, that will affect all occupational therapy staff.
- RCOT and UNISON work together to make sure our members concerns are heard – whether it's about pay, health and safety, discrimination or the future direction of occupational therapy services.

Indemnity Insurance

- You need to have a professional indemnity arrangement as a condition of registration with the HCPC. When registering, they ask people to make a professional declaration to confirm that it is / will be in place and that it provides appropriate cover.
- RCOT professional indemnity cover is for all members, whether employed or self-employed, but NOT their employer and provides £10 million cover for each member on a loss occurring basis. The policy is worldwide excluding USA/Canada but only for claims first made in the European Union, Channel Islands and Australia.
- The policy does not provide cover for any type of company or a partnership. If cover is required for any type of company or partnership a separate policy will need to be arranged in the name of that entity. [Find out more about the professional indemnity policy](#)

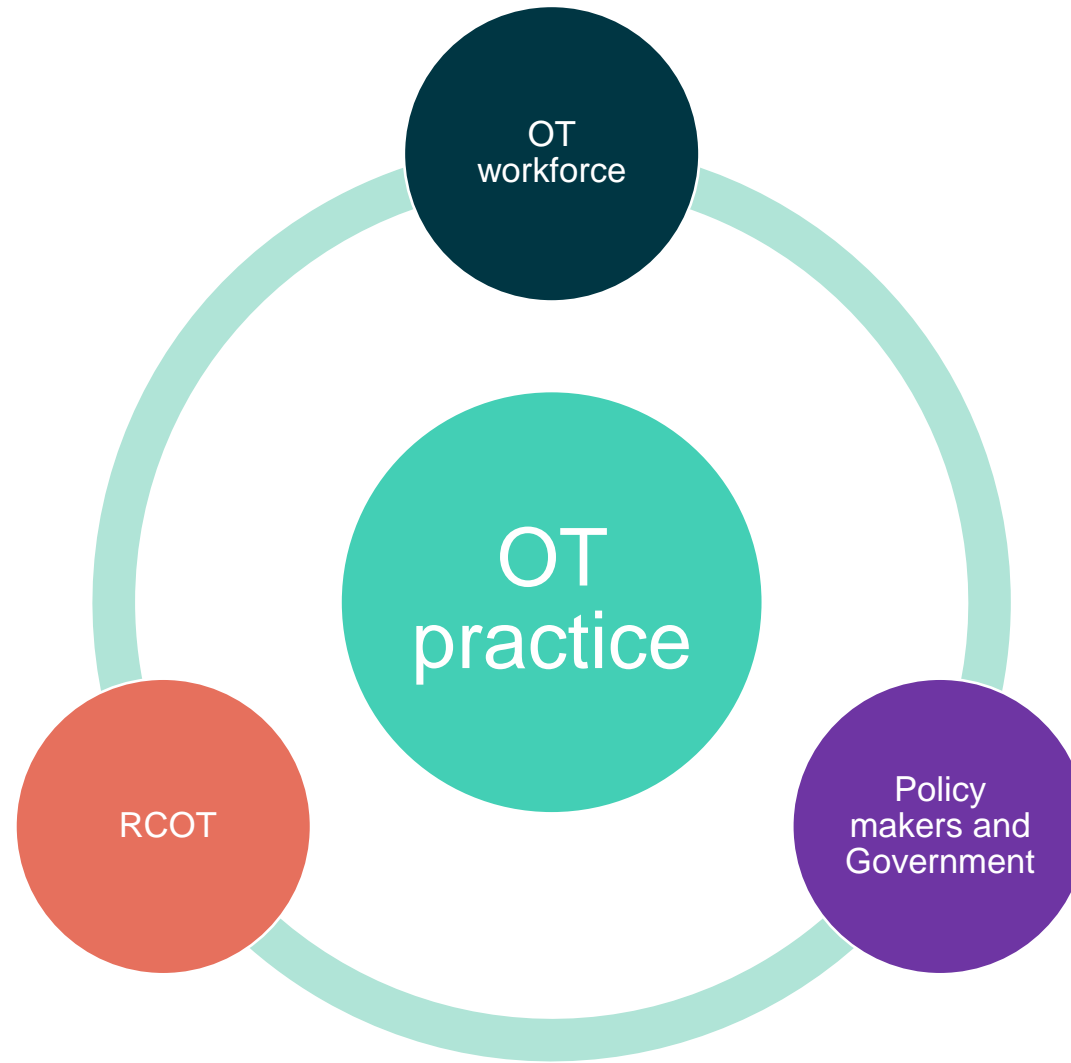

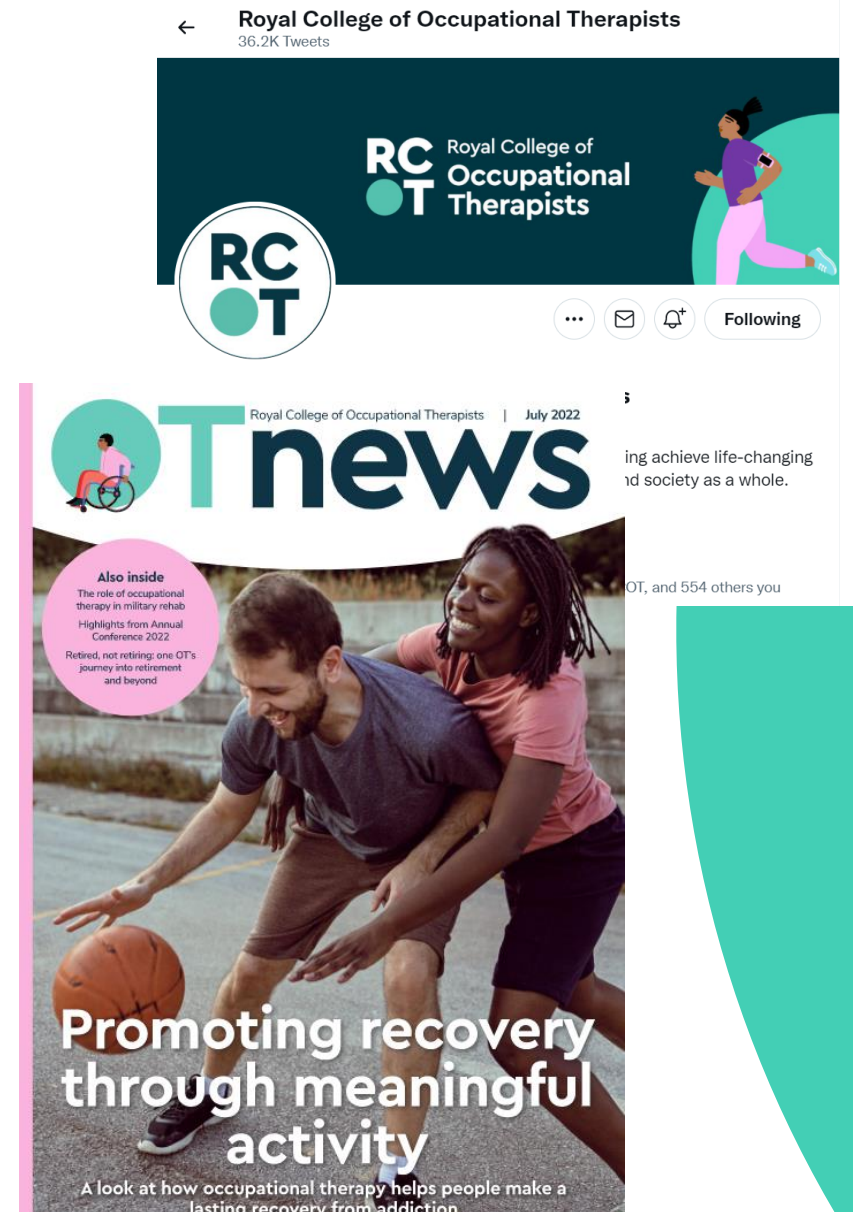
