RCOT Research Foundation

- Research Priority Grant: one grant of up to £100,000 for research that includes developmental opportunities for occupational therapists within the research. The lead applicant must have a PhD.
- Research Career Development Grant: one or two grants of up to £20,000 total for research that supports the development of an occupational therapist researcher.
- Systematic Review Grant: one or two grants of up to £20,000 total



RCOT Research Foundation – what do we fund?

- Funding for the later stages of a doctorate
- Build upon doctoral findings with further research
- Begin to develop or further develop a new intervention manual, tool or assessment
- Explore the useability of an assessment or process
- Understand the experience of people with lived experience or occupational therapists who provide services with the aim of improving the experience or service
